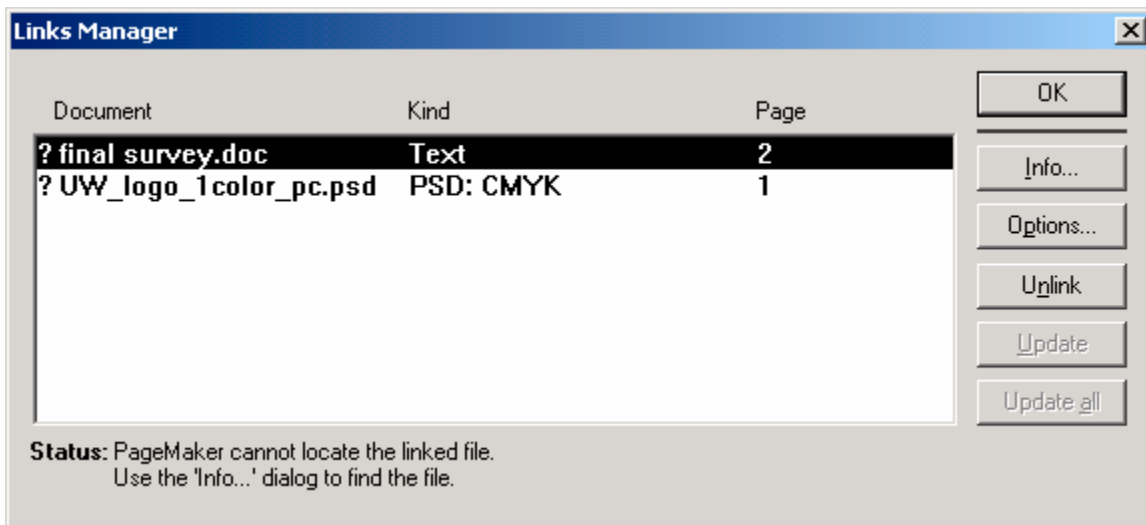
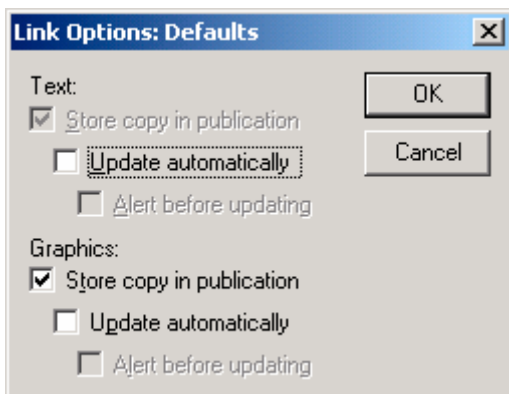


Export PDF from Pagemaker 7 (Windows)

1) Before printing, check the Links Manager; make sure all the link graphics are updated. If you see the “?” in front of Document, the Document is not linked. Please relink the graphic by clicking the “info” button.



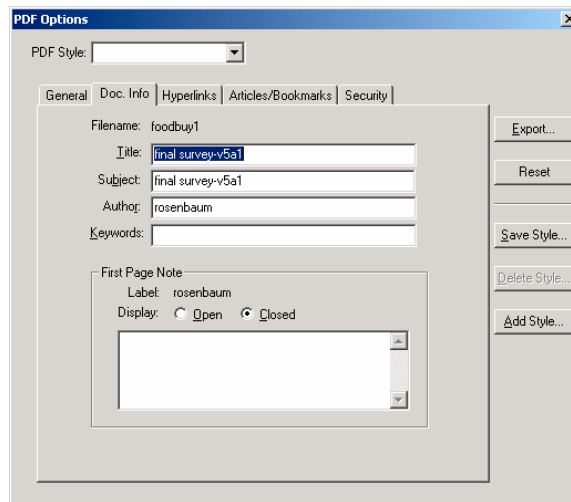
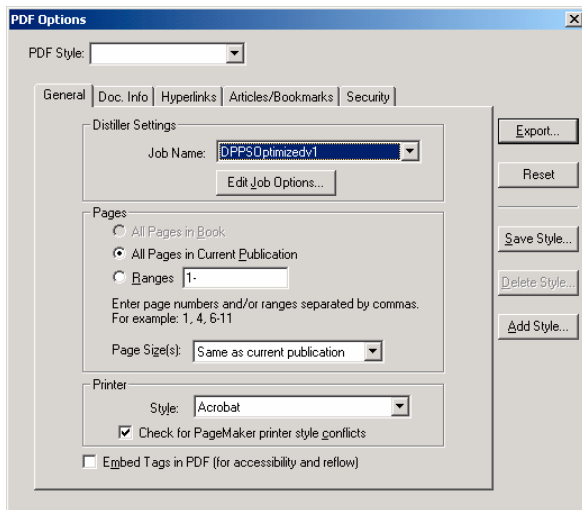
2) Click “Options” in the Link Manager and Match the setting shown below.



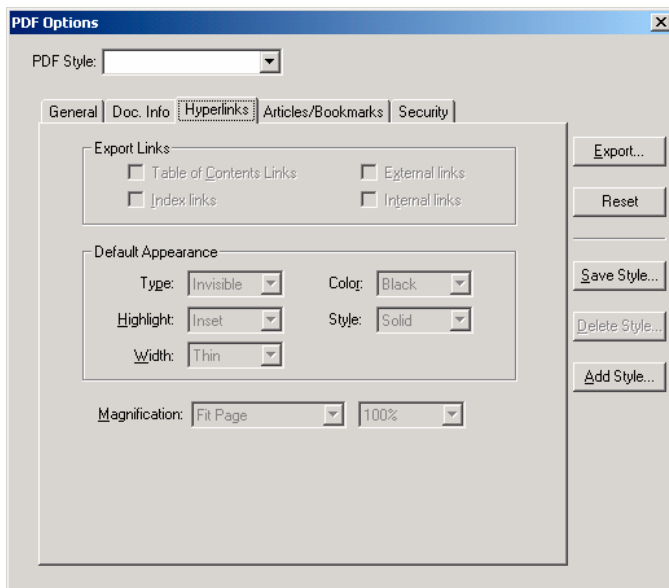
3) After checking all the linking graphics and fonts, you can start export file into PDF by clicking on “Export” in the File menu and selecting “PDF”. The PDF options box should show up. Select “DPPSOptimizedv1” in the PDF style drop-down menu and click “Export” button to create PDF file and skip following instructions. Otherwise, please follow instructions below.

In the General tab, change the Distiller Settings to “DPPSOptimizedv1”. If you don’t see that available, please go back to the PDF instruction guide to install the job options in Distiller.

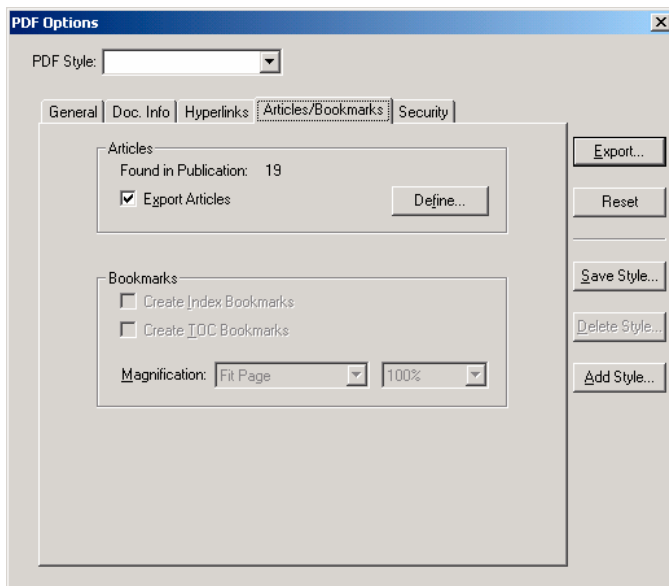
4) Click on Doc. Info tab.



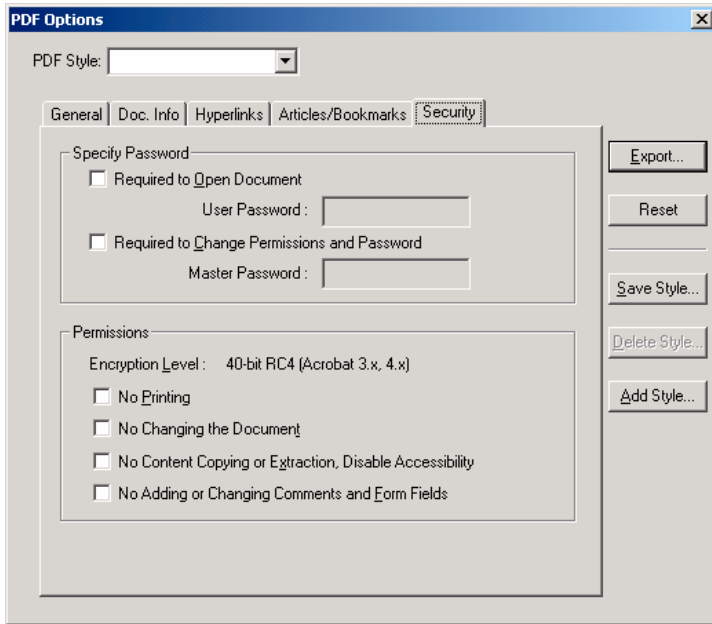
5) Click on Hyperlinks tab.



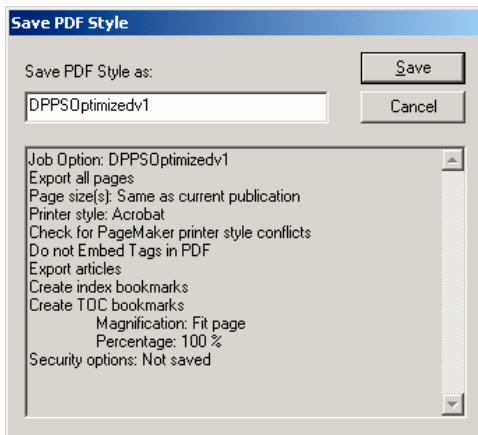
6) Click on Articles/Bookmarks tab.



7) All the security setting should be unchecked and click “Save Style”.



8) Name the PDF style as “DPPSOptimizedv1” and click “save”



9) Finally, Click Export button to export file into PDF. Name the PDF file and click save. The PDF should be create in few seconds.
